THE CHALLENGE

Hospitalized patients generally spend much of their day in bed. Whether in the ICU or in other hospital units, immobility and its associated negative consequences increase length of stay and hospital-acquired harms, leading to worse patient outcomes. Once at home after hospitalization, patients are physically more vulnerable, with negative consequences such as increased falls, too often resulting in hospital re-admission.

THE OUTCOMES

The implementation of AMP provides structured quality improvement processes to promote a culture of activity and mobility:

- Reduces length of stay
- Decreases re-admissions
- Improves patient outcomes

THE SOLUTION

The AMP multidisciplinary program aims to support health care providers that want to change the culture of patient immobility by providing caregivers with the tools and support needed to design and implement structured quality improvement processes to successfully increase patient activity and mobility.
