Routine and Urgent Care:



Assessment & treatment of:

- » Upper respiratory infections (cough, cold, sore throat)
- » Digestive disorders (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)
- » Headaches
- » Sprains/strains and lacerations
- » Skin infections
- » Emergent and routine referrals

Preventive Care:



Routine physical examinations with:

- » Comprehensive laboratory tests
- » Routine vaccinations
- » Health education
- » Wellness coaching

Occupational Medicine:



- » Assessment and treatment of work-related injuries, coordination of care and ancillary services and referrals
- » Post-offer employment physical exams (DOT certification)
- » Ergonomic evaluations
